COOL MILK

Due to a change in legislation with regards to the School Food Plan all parents are now entitled to be able to purchase milk for their children.

The school has registered with Cool Milk for children in Years 3 to 6. If you wish to arrange the purchase of milk please go to <u>www.coolmilk.com</u> and register, alternatively a leaflet is being sent home with children in Years 3 to 6 for registration.

If you register your child for milk they will need to come up to the office to collect it at break time.

For children in EYFS to Year 2 their milk is provided via the Universal Free School Meals Program, so if your child has a hot lunch in school they get their milk provided free of charge.

Universal Free School Meals

The Universial Free School Meals system is now working extremely well. If your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 they are entield to a Universal Free School Meal. Please do encourage them to try having a hot meal at school - you don't need to register but menus are available to view on the Chartwell's website. Just visit www.mealselector.co.uk
