### Teaching Staff

You will already be aware that Mr Fauvel and Mr Cox have both gained well-deserved promotions and will be leaving at the end of this term. We wish them every success in their new posts. Miss Gunn is also leaving at the end of this term and we wish her every happiness in her new school. We will also be saying goodbye to Ms Kim Mirceta (better known to the children as Ms Kim and by staff as Kim the Gym!) Kim has had a long association with the school as a specialist PE teacher and will be greatly missed. Miss Lentz is reducing her full time hours to part time next year and will be job-sharing with Ms Gerring, and then Mrs Hawkins (whom returns from maternity leave in October).
