This comes at a time when school funding is incredibly tight and this will enable us to improve and expand our outdoor learning provision. We will keep you up to date with the project as the months unfold. Following our FOSS non-uniform day on the last day of the spring term we raised another £226.95 for our iPad fund. The grand total now stands at £2,234.95 so we are now close to reaching the half way mark of our £5,000 target.

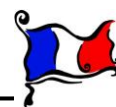
Hot Weather Reminder

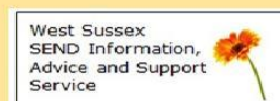
