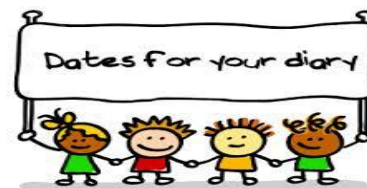
Katrina Wright – Staff Governor
