#### Accommodation

Summerlea School was built in 1998 and has been extended to accommodate 14 classrooms (each class has a tree name), a hall, a library, an Art and DT workroom, and an ICT Suite, as well as several offices and meeting rooms.

The school building is light and bright and very well equipped. There are two hard surfaced playgrounds, each containing activity trails.

We also have a large field and incredible forest school area - that the children absolutely love!

### The School Day

Our school day begins promptly at 8.30am and finishes at 3.00pm. We open our classroom doors at 8.20am.

The children have a one hour lunch break and a 15 minute morning break. Our EYFS and KS1 children often have an afternoon break as well.

#### **Our Team**



Our staff team is led by a leadership team consisting of a Headteacher, two deputy headteachers, Senior Leaders and Team Leaders (who are responsible for directly overseeing operations and teaching and learning across the school).

Behaviour has always been of a very high standard here at Summerlea and we work hard to maintain this. We encourage and reward pupils in a variety of ways.

We value the all-round child and many of our rewards are centred around our Summerlea Seven. We are also very focussed on the standards of our work and children have the opportunity to have their work published in the bronze, silver and gold celebration books.

Additionally, children also receive Star Pupil Awards for their achievements which are given out in a whole school assembly every Friday.

Other rewards at Summerlea include Headteacher's termly award certificates,

stickers, classroom shared rewards and 100% Attendance Certificates for classes and individual pupils.

#### Creativity

At Summerlea we provide our children with a creative curriculum using 'Creative Kickstarts' and organise special events and days to inspire and engage them fully in their learning.

- We encourage all students and staff to have big dreams and believe through hard work and positivity they can achieve anything: valuing the ambition of every person—the building blocks for future greatness.





#### **METEORS Wrap-Around Care**

We have a full wrap around care provision at Summerlea School. We operate a breakfast club and after school club on site in our specially designed rooms. Come and have breakfast from 7.30am and stay at school until 5.30pm Monday to Friday.

Allowing you to work around your child's education is very important to us and the community we belong to.

There is a charge to parents/carers for this club.

#### **Other Clubs**

We are very fortunate to have such an enthusiastic staff team who kindly and voluntarily run a number of after school clubs and some lunchtime activities for our children. We also have a number of outside agencies involved in high-level provision at the school including links with Brighton and Hove Foundation, Sussex Cricket, Giants Gymnastics, Premier Education and Sama Karate.

#### trips to go on where you get School **Trips and Visits**

At Summerlea, we believe that first hand experiences are essential in giving purpose and meaning to learning. In order to enhance our pupils' experiences and ensure that children understand that learning takes place beyond the school building and grounds, the



visits and residential trips. Parents/carers are asked to make a voluntary contribution to help facilitate such trips and we welcome the support of parents/carers on our visits.

#### Home Learning

Home learning is very important to everyone at Summerlea. We acknowledge that it is a vital role in our partnerships with our parents and carers and want to get it right! We evolve our expectations as the children get older but the fundamentals of reading to your child - and hearing them read to you - remain the most important source of home learning there can ever be. Weekly mathematics and spellings also go home regularly and we want to make sure that the exciting learning journey that

your child goes through at Summerlea continues when

they get home.

#### **Forest School**

One of the best things about Summerlea is our countyleading Forest School provision. Every year children experience a half-term of forest school sessions led by our level 3 leaders. We believe forest school develops the whole child and gives them life-long skills that employers look for, such as resilience and problemsolving. We can't wait to show you!





### Joining Us

West Sussex Education
Authority is no longer
issuing booklets and paper
application forms for
admissions to our school.
Instead, parents and carers receive
a personalised letter detailing their
catchment school, how to apply and
the national deadline.

An application must be submitted online. Families without internet access at home are able to apply online at libraries for free, but we can also offer any support needed here in school.



**Did you know...?** We have one of the best libraries in the locality and lots of investment has gone into this - we want to become a real 'reading' school!.

#### **School Admissions Code**

The code places an emphasis on pupils starting in the September following their fourth birthday, as is the current policy in West Sussex, but gives <u>parents</u> the right to <u>choose</u> from September 2011 whether they wish their child to start full-time or part-time, as long as children are receiving full-time education in the term following their fifth birthday.

For the last few years here at Summerlea, we have already given parents/carers the choice of whether they wish their child to be full or part-time in September and we



find that this works extremely successfully. Parents still have the right to defer entry to later in the academic year and in such cases, a place offered in reception will be held open for the child for that intake year.


#### Summerlea PTA
