Staying Healthy - winter germs!

Some of you will know that we have had unusually high cases of illness in one year group. As a precaution, we have contacted Public Health England who have reassured us that we are taking all the right measures that became familiar to us during the pandemic! Please can we ask that you remind your children of good hand and respiratory hygiene routines which continue in school too. Here's a reminder on our sickness policy and medicine before school:

In school we take great care to ensure pupils are fully cared for should they fall ill during the day. However, pupils should not be sent to school when they are clearly unwell. Similarly, if your child has suffered from diarrhea and/or vomiting, we would expect them to not be in school for 48 hours after the problem has ceased. In brief, if a child has to take medicine etc, before they feel well enough to come to school, then they should not be in school. If your child is going to be absent from school, please phone the school office as early as possible in the morning, enabling us to record their absence in the register.

Uniform

We have noticed that some children are coming to school in unsuitable footwear. Logos and colours on trainers are not part of our uniform. School shoes / trainers must be plain black. A reminder too about jewellery which should not be worn unless it is a watch or small stud earrings. These will need to be removed or covered for PE lessons.

SPC Update

The dedicated pupil council team are in the process of purchasing some new play equipment. They are also pulling together the traffic survey details to contact West Sussex County Council as well as costing out new signs to remind drivers about how to stay safe. A polite reminder from our pupils to take care when collecting bikes and scooters from the shed. Many are getting knocked over and damaged in the rush.


