Due to a change in legislation with regards to the School Food Plan all parents and carers are now entitled to be able to purchase milk for their children.

The school has registered with Cool Milk for children in Years 3 to 6. If you wish to arrange the purchase of milk please go to www.coolmilk.com and register, alternatively a leaflet is being sent home with children in Years 3 to 6 for registration.

As we have had such a big uptake for milk we now have milk monitors who deliver it to the classrooms each day!

For children in EYFS to Year 2 their milk is provided via the Universal Free School Meals Program, so if your child has a hot lunch in school they get their milk provided free of charge.
