Dear Year 2 Parents and Carers,

In our final half term of Year 2, our big question will be "Wild or Tame?" and we will be studying the habitats of different animals, especially those that live in Madagascar. As an exciting experience in this learning journey we are planning a visit from a company called 'RepTylers' on Thursday 20th June. They will bring in a range of unusual animals for the children to observe (and even handle if they wish!) and hear from the experts all about them.

We are requesting a voluntary contribution of **£4.30** per child in order to cover the cost of RepTylers coming to visit. Payment should be made via your online account on ParentPay. Although the contribution is voluntary, it should be pointed out that the workshop could not take place unless all parents and carers, who are able, are willing to contribute.
