Mrs Corley Black, Mrs Kirkwood and Mrs Verveken also deliver interventions across the school in the afternoons.

Mrs Palmer is a dual role TA, covering teachers across the school as well as supporting in classes. For the first half of the autumn term, Mrs Palmer will be based in Year 1 when not covering.

Mrs Burge and Mrs Moynihan are Higher Level Teaching Assistants and cover PPA and leadership time across the school. Mrs Viney is a Higher Level Teaching Assistant and is part of our Inclusion Team, leading Pupil Premium and Family Support.

# Summer 2017 Activities




It's that time of year again, long sunny summer days!

We would ask that payment be on the day and given to group lead Kirsten Bennetts.


