

### Important reminders

### Safeguarding at Summerlea Phishing and the secure padlock

Good advice to children and young people is to always check the web address bar to see if it has the little padlock on the left hand side and the web address starts with 'https', with the **s** denoting secure. Security Safeguarding researchers are finding that criminals are also using the padlock in the hope that you'll be tricked into thinking the site is legitimate and/or safe.

It's still good advice to check for a secure connection, but users should also check:

- Grammar and spelling (this is the easiest and the most common).
- Suspicious popups making outlandish claims (e.g. win an iPad).
- A slight alteration to the web address (an obvious one might be Barc1ays, where the L has been changed to a figure

### Always talk to a trusted adult

It's one of the important messages we give to children, but when using this message, please be careful. This message cannot be used as a 'rule', it needs context around it. Remember, one of the processes an offender might try is to establish trust. **Safer Internet Searching** – Swiggle.org.uk Swiggle is a child-friendly search engine from the Online Safety experts at SWGfL. Designed to make searching the internet for images or content more than just a bit hit and miss. Swiggle can help you with your first steps on the road to better online searching.
