Curriculum and homework

Curriculum Guides for all year groups were published in the first week of term and provide key information about this half term. They were sent electronically via ParentMail and are also available to download from our website http://www.summerlea.w-sussex.sch.uk/ > Our School > Curriculum & Assessment > Curriculum Booklets. Hard copies are available from the main foyer. Homework/home-learning activities were sent home via your child. Copies were sent electronically via ParentMail and are available on our website by going to Learning Zone > How to help > Homework and selecting the relevant year group. Again, hard copies are available from the main foyer. Linked to this, a reminder that children in Key Stage 1 and 2 should be regularly practising their set spellings at home and if you need any guidance about this to please speak to your child's class teacher. Thank you for your support.

Coats and Uniform Reminder

A reminder to please ensure your child has a named and waterproof coat in school. We like the children to be able to go outside whatever the weather and to be warm and dry at break times and lunchtimes, as well as during other outdoor activities. Thank you.

It is also important that children are wearing the correct uniform to school, as per our policy. The children returned to school after the Christmas holidays looking very smart and we want this to continue. A reminder that shoes should be plain, black and sensible. Plain black trainers are acceptable. Boots and shoes with high heels or heavy buckles and chains should not be worn for safety reasons. Socks/tights should be plain white, plain grey, plain dark green or plain black. Hair accessories should also be in these colours only. Nail varnish is not acceptable and should be removed before coming to school. Thank you for your support in ensuring these

You do not need to order for UIFSM pupils (children in Years R, 1 and 2) and Free School Meal pupils as they are all entitled to a hot school lunch.

Scooter Safety

Children are expected to dismount scooters when coming onto the school grounds and to wheel them along. This applies to younger siblings as well, in order to ensure everyone's safety. We have also had a report from a concerned parent about children riding their scooters down the middle of roads around the school. Children also need to be mindful of pedestrians on pavements, as the start and end of the school day are particularly busy times.

If your child uses a scooter please remind them of how to keep themselves and others safe.

Meet our Vice Chair of Governors

Hello, my name is Clive Patterson-Lett and I am the newly appointed Vice Chair of Governors at Summerlea. I joined the Governing Body in February 2019 after a 30 year career in the Police Service. Following retirement, I was approached by a member of Summerlea staff and asked if I would be interested in joining as a Coopted Governor. I leapt at the chance, seeing it as an opportunity to deploy my policing experience with particular interest in people and leadership development, and Safeguarding.

One of the first things to impact me when I came to the school was what a friendly and nurturing place it is, with happy young people and dedicated and motivated staff.

Since joining the Governing Body, I have taken an interest in specific issues such as broadening the use of the IRIS system to gather and promote good teaching practice as part of our response to the most recent OFSTED inspection. To broaden governor representation, I have recently rewritten the role profile for Co Governors which appears as part of our recruitment package. In order to hear the experience of staff at the school, all staff will now be given the option of a face to face exit interview with a Governor. This is in addition to the questionnaire which we are already using.

As part of the School Improvement Plan, I have responsibility (along with two other Governors) for improving communication and community links both internally and externally. As part of this, we are scoping the use of a Summerlea Governor Facebook page to increase accessibility to the Governing Body as well as raising our profile. We are planning to explore how to engage and work with parents in different ways and we are all keen that you will see more of us at school events where we will be available to speak to you about the work of the Governing Body and hear your feedback.

Finally, this month I have taken on the role of Safeguarding Lead for the Governors. This is an area of responsibility I am familiar with from my policing days, and I look forward to working with the Deputy Headteacher to refresh my knowledge and ensure that Summerlea continues to be a safe place.

No Nuts and Healthy School Reminder

We ask that children are not sent to school with items that contain nuts. We have a number of children with severe allergies who may require medical attention if they came into contact with them. We may ask anyone who brings in these items to leave them unopened and take them home.

On the subject of lunches and snacks, we are a healthy school which means 'everything in moderation'. We have noticed an increase in children being sent to school with chocolate bars and sweets on a regular basis. Our Healthy Snack & Packed Lunch Policy states the following:

Suggestions for food to NOT TO INCLUDE in a healthy packed lunch:

- Confectionery such as chocolate bars or sweets are not allowed at lunch time.
- Nut or nut products (although they can be very healthy) because of the danger to other children with allergies.
- Fizzy drinks as these are very unhealthy and are likely to make a mess and spoil food.






