

Handwriting activities

At Summerlea School we use a handwriting scheme called 'Letterjoin'. This begins by teaching the children pre-cursive handwriting from EYFS and then eventually teaches the children to join their letters by Year 2. Until the children have developed fine and gross motor skills they will find letter formation challenging. This is why we place a huge emphasis on gross and fine motor development in the Early Years.
