
Writing activities

By the end of EYFS the expected standard for writing is for children to be able to 'use their phonic knowledge to write words in ways which match their spoken sounds. They also write some irregular common words. They write simple sentences which can be read by themselves and others. Some words are spelt correctly and others are phonetically plausible.' Here is an example of a piece of writing that has been assessed as 'expected' level at the end of the EYFS:
