

## Continuation of Learning Year 1

### Day 1:

#### **Maths:**

Find 5 objects at home, can you order them by weight? You could try using kitchen scales to help you with this. Can you find if the weight is on the packaging?

Now compare the 5 objects by height – you could use a ruler or just see if you can do this by looking at them. Use our measure language (taller, shorter, tallest, shortest) to compare them.

Now do the same by comparing their lengths.

You could record what you have found out in your book by drawing pictures.
