Can you get 10 small items that are the same - pasta (if you have any!), marbles, matches, pens, pencils, crayons or anything else you can easily count with!

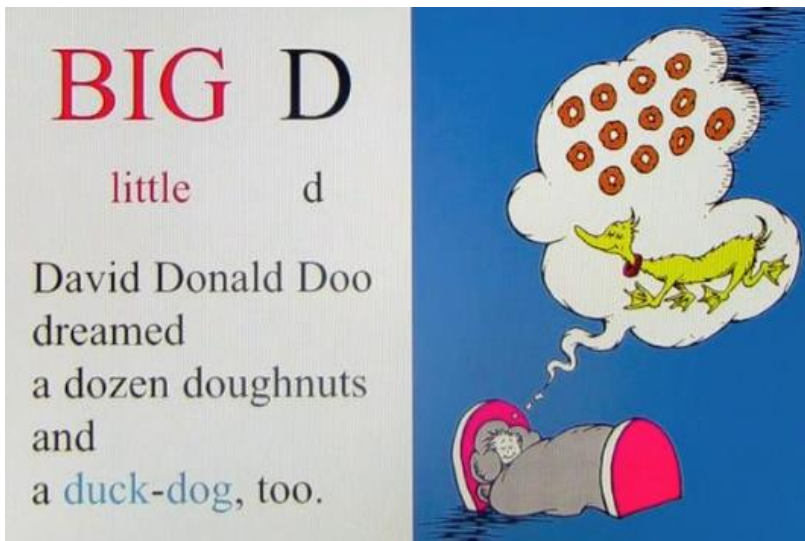
How many different ways can you find to sort them into equal and unequal groups. Can you record it in your book like this:
