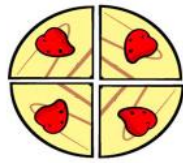


Year 3 Daily Activities - Day 3

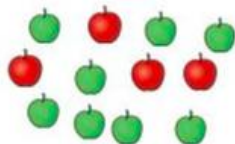
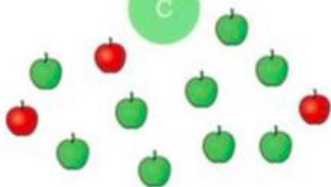
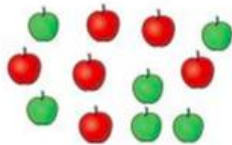

FRENCH:

Today you are going to revise and practise asking someone how they are and how they might respond. You might have to teach the members of your family a little bit of French to help with this activity!

Question: "Ca va?" Which means "How are you?"

Reply: "Ca va bien!" Which mean "I am good!" or "Ca va mal."
