

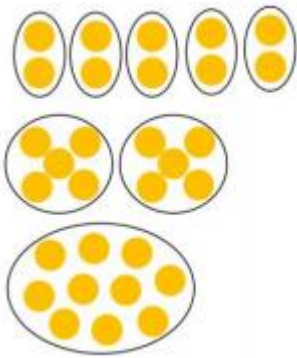
Good morning

Have a look at the picture below. What is the same and what is different?



Can you write a number sentence and STEM sentence for each picture.

This is my example for the last picture:

1 group of 10 dots equals 10.

Now a bit of a problem for you to solve!

You can use objects to help you or draw pictures to help you solve it if you want to.

I am thinking of a number between 20 and 30.

I can only make equal groups of 5 with it.

What must my number be? (I'll tell you at the end of the page)

What happens when I try make groups of 2 with it?

What happens when I try make groups of 10 with it?

You need to go on another mini beast hunt!

You need to write a report to explain what you found and where you found it.

The word 'and' is called a conjunction: it is a word that can link two ideas together.

You can tell me what you found AND where - 'I found a woodlouse AND it was hiding under a log.'

You could tell me what you found AND what it was doing - 'I found a snail AND it was crawling along a leaf.'

Have a go as you write your report. You will also see lots of time connectives listed: words like first, then and next that show the order in which you did things.

Don't forget to use these too.
