

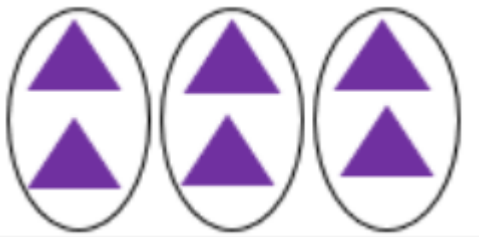

How many are there in total?

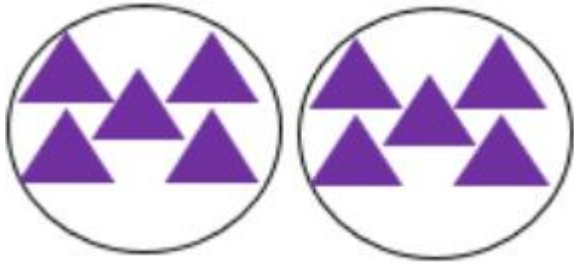

Today you need to be a mini teacher and check Sidney's letter for correct punctuation.

Remember a capital letter needs to be used:

- For all names
- To start a new sentence (so they will follow a full stop if you write more than one sentence)

Full stops need to be used to finish each sentence you write - remember to read your work aloud to help you hear where each sentence starts and stops.

Extension: You could write a letter back to Sidney. If you do remember to add capital letters and full stops yourself.

You could also try to add a question into your reply. If you write a question use a ? to end the sentence instead of a full stop.
