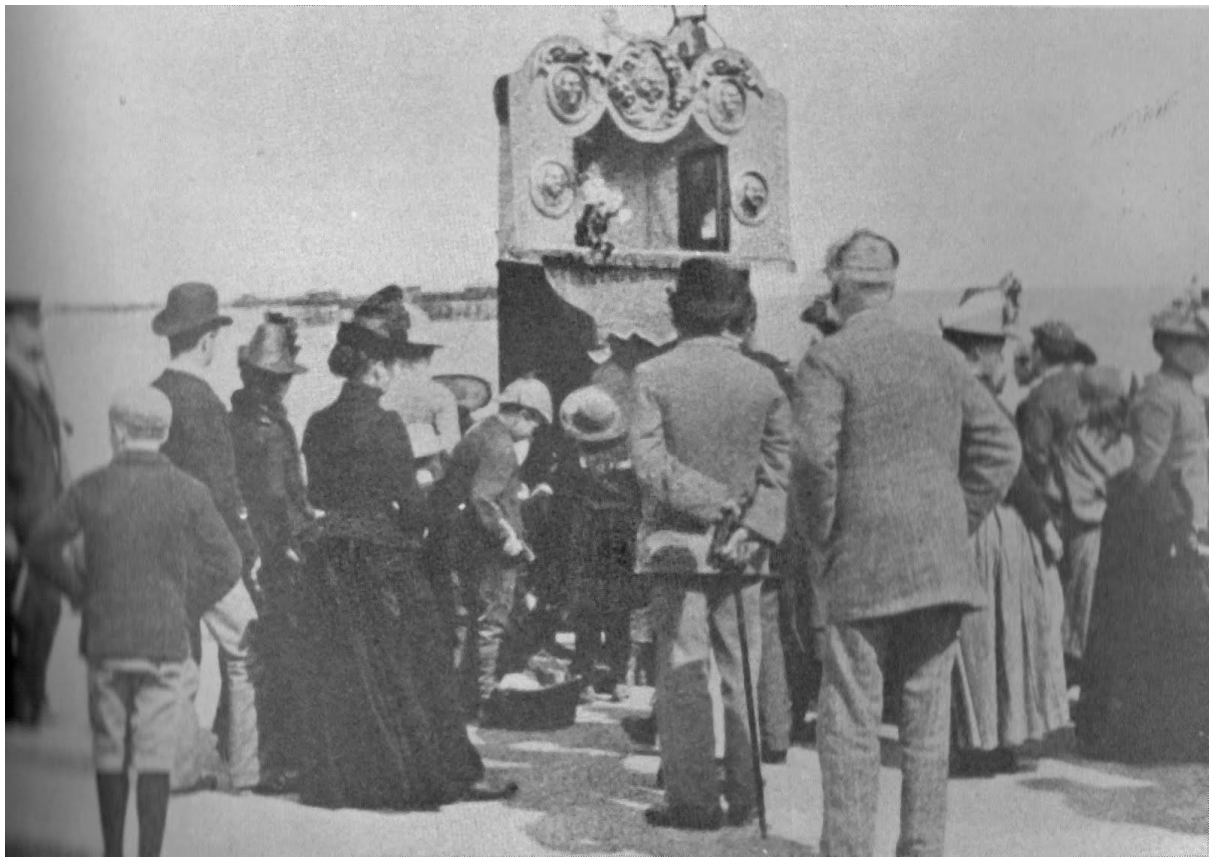

Think about all the things you have learnt about seaside holidays in the past and what they are like now, in the present. Complete the table by sorting the things into the right columns.

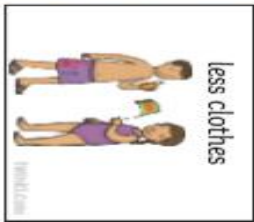
