**pebbles:** small, smooth, round stones found by the edge of the sea.



**pier:** a structure for people to walk along that is built out into the sea.



**cliff:** a steep rock face close to the edge of the sea.



**harbour:** a place by the seaside where boats can stay safely in the water.



**bay:** a place where the coast bends inwards and sea fills the space.



**funfair:** a place where there are roundabouts and other rides, stalls and shows.



**lighthouse:** a tower with a bright light that warns or guides ships at sea.



**beach:** land by the edge of the sea, usually covered with sand or small stones.



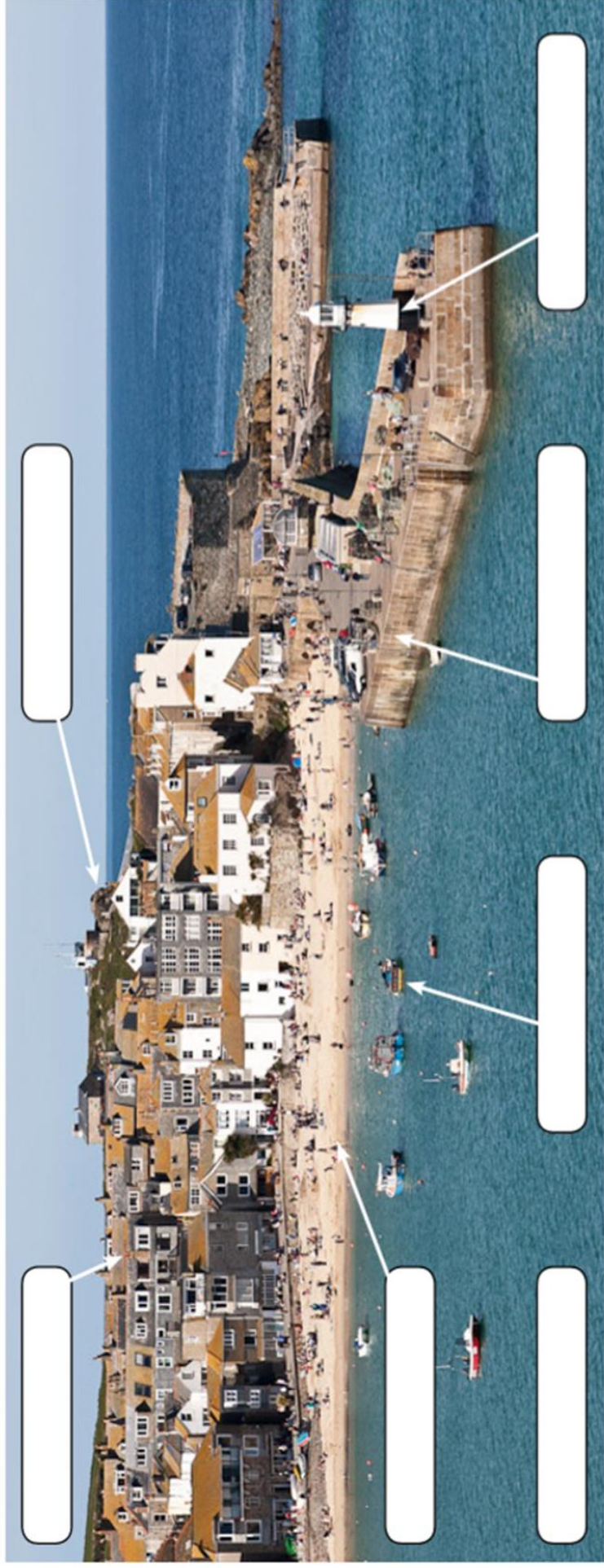
**campsite:** an place used for camping, filled with tents and caravans.



**sand dune:** hills or mounds of sand held together by plants, often near the sea.
