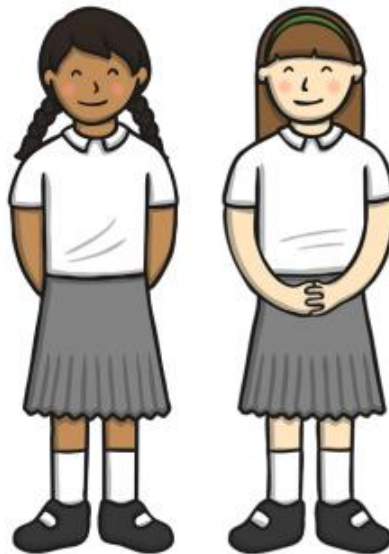
My number has four tens.
