STAGE 4: Entrance Ticket Prices (Income)

Now that you know how much it costs to run your zoo for the month, you need to think about how much you are going to charge each guest. Are you going to charge the same for adults and children?

Make sure that your entrance ticket prices aren't too expensive- you don't want to put people off! However, if you don't charge enough, you won't make enough money to pay your staff and cover your monthly costs!

How much are you going to charge for adult tickets? How much are you going to charge for child tickets?

Will you have any promotional offers?

In this table, it shows how many adults and children visit your zoo each day. You need to work out how much you will make each day in entrance fees, and how much you will make in total.

If you have access to a calculator, you may use it for this task!

First, you will need to add up how many children come to your zoo over the 30 days, then multiply this number by the price of a child ticket.

Next, you will need to do the same thing for the adults!

Now, you will need to add the totals together, to get your income.
