Our current proposal for clubs will see the Key Stage 2 playground divided into two and clubs to be run parallel strictly remaining in their Year Group Bubble. Where possible, we have tried to match the club to a day that the year group will have curriculum PE. For EYFS, your club will be run from the Key Stage 1 playground.

In the event that your child has a club on a non-PE day, they will need to bring in a change of shoes and be prepared to participate in uniform if the opportunity to change into anything other than shoes does not present itself.

Children can be collected from the Key Stage 2 playground and we ask that social distancing remains whilst queueing for collection and when on school site.

For EYFS collection please enter the school through the normal main gates and meet Mrs Robins at the gates to the KS1 playground.

There are conditions that will affect the running of clubs that unfortunately cannot be avoided. If there is adverse weather we cannot provide an indoor alternative but will contact you in advance to notify of any cancellation. This closure also applies if a staff member is away from work for unforeseen circumstance. **Please note**, on Thursday 24th June all extra-curricular clubs will be cancelled due to the 'Road to Tokyo' Sports Celebrations that are taking place that day.

All sports clubs will start week commencing Monday the 14th of June 2021.

Please note club capacity is limited and a waiting list will be produced if there is an oversubscription.

We hope you are equally as excited as we are to be able to continue offering extra-curricular sport next half term.
