


Governors will be invited, by their year group, to special events throughout the year and their school visits will

A Few Polite Reminders

No Dogs

Please remember that dogs are <u>not</u> permitted on the school premises. We also ask that parents do not tie dogs to our school fences or gates whilst dropping off/picking up their children.

Safe Scooting

It is brilliant to see so many children scooting to school. This is a great way of promoting a healthy lifestyle and fun too! However, please can you remind your child that <u>as soon as they arrive at school they need to dismount</u> their scooter.

Children are not permitted to ride their scooters around the playgrounds at the beginning or end of the school day in the interest of safety.
