Dear Parents and Carers

Well, Spring has certainly sprung this week and long may it last! It's been lovely to be able to enjoy the sunny weather and appreciate the signs of Spring around our school grounds. A huge thank you to the green-fingered Mr and Mrs Saunders who do such a great job of maintaining the gardens all year round.

Comic Relief and Ukraine

I am delighted to be able to let you know that we raised a brilliant £340.20 for Comic Relief last Friday through our dress-up day. Thank you for your support for this worthwhile charity.

We have also been informed by Astra Recycling that last week they sent **15 tons** of aid to Ukraine. They said the outpouring of love and generosity from all communities has been overwhelming. A big thank you to everyone who donated to their #MarchforUkraine campaign.

Dragons' Den market

A reminder that the Dragons' Den market is now scheduled to take place next Friday 1st April. As per the original arrangements communicated, each class will have an opportunity to visit the stalls during the school day. All products will range from 50p-£2. We are asking that if your child wishes to purchase an item from the market, they bring up to £2 in small change in a named and sealed envelope. If you have any questions about this, please do speak to your child's class teacher. (Money previously sent into school for this event has been kept in our safe and will be returned to children on the day.)

School uniform and PE kit

A few parents have asked recently whether we will be returning to children coming to school in uniform and changing into PE kit at school on PE days, as used to happen prior to the pandemic. I have decided that we will return to this from the start of the new academic year in September 2022. The reason for not doing so straight away is to allow parents ample notice to purchase uniform and PE kit (including PE bags) as necessary, as I know our uniform suppliers reported changing patterns in purchases over the past two years linked to our Covid-19 measures. It is important that children look smart and come to school in the correct uniform, ready to learn, and I hope a return to this next academic year will help us to maintain the highest possible standards in this area. In the meantime, please ensure your child is wearing the correct uniform / PE kit as per our policy. To clarify, for the remainder of this year children





















should continue to come to school wearing PE kit on PE days. Thank you for your support and understanding with this. Another reminder about the change will be sent closer to the end of the school year.

Staffing news

I am sorry to have to let you know that Mrs Wright (Finance Assistant) has made the difficult decision to resign from her role after almost 11 years at Summerlea. 
