

Remote learning activities - EYFS Week 5 & 6 Spring 2

Phonics:

Go on a word hunt - finding words and keywords hidden around your home. (I, the, to, he, she, me, be, no, go, into, you etc)

Play 'matching words'. Find items from around your house and write down labels for them. Can you match the label with the item? E.g. bear, car, pen, pan, tin, pot, cat, dog, pig etc

Reading / communication / listening

Pick a story and read it together, working on comprehension skills. Ask questions such as 'what happened at the beginning/ middle/ end?' 'Who are the characters?', 'Where is the story set?', 'Why is the character feeling sad?'

Play simon says to develop listening skills.

Number

Please continue to count as frequently as possible.

Follow a simple recipe and have a go at measuring out the ingredients.

Have a go at subitising! This is where you can look at a quantity and know how many are there without counting. Try this out with quantities up to 5. You could either roll a dice, use objects or playing cards!

Writing

Use the sound mat we have attached to our Class Dojo page and have a go at writing some or all of the letters. Make sure you are using the correct pencil grip!

Write down a recipe of your choice. You could ask your grown up to help you with some of the trickier words but have a go at sounding out others e.g. egg, butter...

Physical development

Peg out the washing- this will develop your finger muscles.

Go on to Youtube and find some yoga videos. We love 'Cosmic Kids' in class!

Personal, social and emotional development

Play a turn taking game e.g snakes and ladders

Take a look at some family photographs. Enjoy spending time talking about these with your grown ups.
