Curriculum

You may already be aware that a new National Curriculum came into force in September 2014 for Key Stages 1 to 4. and provides statutory guidance of what is to be taught in all maintained schools in England. Children in Year 2 and 6 will continue to be taught the pre-2014 programmes of study for English, mathematics and science as they will sit the current Key Stage 1 and 2 tests respectively (new tests will be available from 2016). As a result of the new curriculum subject leaders have reviewed curriculum content, coverage and key skills.
