Dear Parents and Carers,

As you are aware we have appointed Mr Joe Todd as the new Headteacher of Summerlea School. Hot School Meals - FINAL REMINDER

The cut-off date for ordering meals for 17 – 21 April is **Thursday 6th April** and for 24 – 28 April is **Thursday 13th April**. Please be aware that these dates fall within the Easter holidays. If you have not completed your order by this date, we cannot guarantee there will be a hot meal available for your child. **This applies for all Free school meals, Universal free meals, and paid meals.** On the log in page of the ParentPay website, if you click on Parent FAQ's it leads you to a page with links to instructions and a number of videos showing you how to manage the account and book meals.

Please note that Monday 17th April will be a jacket potato menu only.

If your child has a packed lunch every day and will not be having any hot meals, please email parentpay@summerleaschool.co.uk to let us know not to chase you.

Check if your child is entitled to free school meals (FSM)

If your child is eligible for FSM you need to get them registered. Even if your child is in EYFS, or does not want a hot meal, it is still worth applying as FSM eligible pupils are entitled to other things such as the Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) programme and the supermarket voucher scheme during holidays and the school will get extra funding (known as the pupil premium) to support your child's learning. Go to this government website to check if your child is eligible. If they are, or if you're not sure, please ask at the office for a form to complete.























P.E. Kits

We would like to remind parents of our P.E. kit policy:

White t-shirt (with or without school logo)

Plain green / black / white shorts – Shorts should be mid-thigh to knee length.

Tracksuit (optional for outdoor PE in colder weather) Jogging bottoms/hoodies should be plain, dark colours (no logos or bright colours)*

- 4. If traffic is coming, let it pass, look all around again and listen
 - 5. When it is safe go straight across the road do not run
 - 6. Keep looking and listening for traffic while you cross


Judith Kerr's Mog The Forgetful Cat
